Please check the timetable to note all the timing for the event. The timetable is packed so **please ensure you listen to the PA for any changes** in the timings on the day that may come forward or back.

SIGNING-ON

07.00 Sunday in the race admin office at the base of the control tower [adjacent to Cafe]

DRIVERS' BRIEFING

0900 Saturday morning in Club Time Attack Clubhouse [situated in the inner paddock]

TICKETS

You should have received your four allocated tickets via email. If not, please check your junk folder and, if they have not landed there, please let Mark our Championship Secretary know directly: secretary@timeattack.co.uk

ARRIVAL & PADDOCK ACCESS

Entry is via the Paddock circuit entrance: From **17.30** Saturday From 07:00 Sunday

Competitors may stay overnight Saturday in the paddock. The paddock is to be vacated by 21:00 Sunday evening

TRAILER PARKING

All trailers must be parked in the trailer parking zone at the bottom of the outer paddock as shown on the event plan. Please park your trailer considerately to ensure there is enough room for all teams. Ensure you lock you trailer as it is left at your own risk.

Please park in the designated Time Attack Championship areas (SEE PADDOCK PLAN) – otherwise your race car risks becoming blocked in!

DO NOT invite friends and family to park in the inner paddock behind your garages or along the back road, these areas will be busy and should only house your support vehicles. All other vehicles should be left outside of the venue and support teams walk in.

THE CLUBHOUSE

The Clubhouse is located in the paddock as per the event plan. Each team has two passes to gain access to the Clubhouse and these are to be collected when you sign on from sign on office. Anyone wishing to enter the Clubhouse MUST wear the lanyard to identify them as a team member. If you are turned away for not having the pass, don't take it personally as the event has thousands of people and we are in a public

area, our guys don't know everyone's faces. Please be considerate in wearing one and if you forget it, be friendly when challenged for it as our guys are doing their best to welcome you.

Access to the Clubhouse can be for anyone from your team so you can pass the lanyards between members as you need and as soon as its set up, its there for you to come and go as you please. It makes a great area for a sit down and relax away from the garages for a quiet moment or chat.

There is a tea, coffee and mineral water station for your use as well as seating.

Food is served for our event team and a few sponsors but not teams so please ensure that you communicate to your own team that visit the Clubhouse that they are welcome to tea and coffee and seating **but not food**. It can be embarassing for all concerned when challenged on this in a crowd so please ensure your guys know how the Clubhouse works before sending them in.

The Clubhouse is for all three Championships and we will conduct the briefings there too so please bear this in mind in the morning when it is very busy. If its someone else's briefing going on, please try to keep out the way as best you can.

SCRUTINEERING

Sunday from 0700-0900 onwards according to classes. Please make your way to scrutineering via the rear road, not the pitlane.

Remember, driver signing-on is from 07:00 and drivers' briefing at 09:00 but there are a lot of cars and drivers from all three Championships to process, be early and get yourself sorted in good time.

If you are missing any stickers or competition numbers, these can be collected when you sign on. **Your car will not pass without them**. You can get them from sign on from 07:00 onwards or the scrutineering bay.

Please ensure your car is well prepared and ready to be scrutineered; otherwise you risk being sent back to your team area to effect repairs and having to re-join at the back of the queue.

AWARDS PRESENTATIONS

Awards (podium) presentations will take place in the paddock at the end of the day directly after the final. **PLEASE ENSURE YOU ARE WEARING YOUR RACE SUIT FOR THE PRESENTATION.**
